

ORDINANCE NO. 76

MOTOR BOAT REGULATION IN PROTECTION LEVEE CANAL

To provide for the regulation of boat traffic in the protection levee canal; to prohibit the operation and traffic of boats with motors in said canal; to provide for penalties for the violation hereof.

BE IT ORDAINED by the mayor and board of aldermen of the Town of Golden Meadow that:

SECTION 1

No person shall operate, drive or run any boat, raft or other water vehicle of any nature whatsoever propelled by a gas, electric or any other kind or type of motor in the canal that lies alongside of the protection levee of said town or any other canals or ditches maintained by said town that have been dug or created in connection with said protection levee or to effect drainage of said town.

SECTION 2

This ordinance shall likewise extend to all such canals or ditches maintained by said town in connection with the said protection levee that lie beyond the corporate limits of said town.

SECTION 3

That if any part of this ordinance should be adjudged unconstitutional, the remainder of said ordinance shall remain in full force and effect and unaffected.

SECTION 4

Every violation of the provisions of the sections of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than One Hundred and No/100 (\$100.00) Dollars or by imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days, or both.
